Africa Days in Olsztyn

The Olsztyn Africa Days organizers invite you to take part in the annual Scientific Colloquium to be held online (ZOOM) on **May 24-25, 2021**

on the subject : Africa during the COVID-19 pandemic. Facts and forecasts

The scientific community of the University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn has been involved for several years in a very important field of research on themes of interest to the African continent. The annual scientific symposium organized by the Faculty of Letters and Human Sciences has become a broad platform, one of the objectives of which is to discuss the issues and challenges facing Africa.

Polish and foreign Africanist researchers meet there every year for an interdisciplinary scientific exchange in various fields of research on Africa.

The theme of this year's conference focuses on the situation in Africa during the pandemic. For over a year, the uncontrolled spread of the COVID-19 virus around the world has affected all ways of life. The pandemic has exacerbated the crisis in African countries with fragile health systems. Another difficulty is related to external aid, including the implementation of vaccination. Depending on the level of development, African countries have taken various measures to control the spread of the disease. Some countries have instituted a state of emergency accompanied by a curfew. On the other hand, we should note the local initiatives and the creativity of African societies in the face of the pandemic: the involvement of young people in social programs, the generosity of businessmen, the creativity of universities in the design of ventilators, creativity in the production of masks, etc. The difficult situation has become an impetus to activate social movements. We propose as topics of discussion, among others: History of the pandemic in Africa Health disaster sizes The impact of COVID-19 on international relations The impact of COVID-19 on the economy The impact of COVID-19 on society The impact of COVID-19 on the health system The means of African countries to fight COVID-19 The media and the pandemic in Africa National solidarity International solidarity

Working languages: Polish, English, French and Russian. The conference will be held online on the Zoom platform. The presentation time of the communication should not exceed 15 minutes.

Papers which have received positive reviews will be published in the scientific series "Africanist Studies in Olsztyn", in the UWM publishing house in Olsztyn.

The call for papers is open until April 23, 2021.

The validation of communications will be carried out before April 30, 2021.

The cost of participation in the colloquium is 30 EURO. The participation fee must be paid before May 14, 2021 to the account of the University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn (the account number will be provided in the letter confirming the validation of the communication).

Information clause
